What to pack in carryon luggage

- All items marked with * above in carryon (documents, money, cameras/electronics, sunscreen, swimsuits, medications, sunglasses and diaper bag)
- · Make it even easier: Wear swimsuits under clothes for embarkation.

When in doubt, leave it out

- Items marked with *** can (and will) be worn other times.
- Women can wear the same dress for both formal nights, just change accessories.
- Women can wear the same pants/skirt a couple of evenings and change tops to keep packing light.
- Men can wear a casual shirt (polo) to dinner one night and on shore excursions another day.
- There's always an onboard laundry service if needed.

Packing for kids

- Make comfort your priority! Comfortable kids are happy kids.
- Flip flops can be tough when the ship rocks or they get wet. For safety, pack sandals instead.
- A favorite toy or blanket makes bedtime better.
